The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of May 10, 19.84.

Pub. Works! Purch. asphalt Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board with two quotes for the purchase of SS-1H Asphalt Émulsion. Mr. Dooley recommended that the Board accept the low quote of Hy-Way Asphalt Products, Inc., Salina, Kansas, in the amount of \$0.6750 per gallon. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be accepted, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.

Jerry Kemberling, noxious weed director, appeared before the Board to recommend the purchase of 8 gallons of Esteron BK, in the total amount of \$244, from Cornbelt Chemical, McCook, Nebraska. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Hiebert that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Kemberling then presented the Board four quotes for the purchase of Formula 40 or 64A. Mr. Kemberling recommended that the Board accept the low quote from Mid-States, Eudora, Kansas, for the following: 2520 gallons, Formula 40, in 5 gallon containers, in the total amount of \$17,136, and 160 gallons, in 1 gallon containers, Formula 40, in the total amount of \$1264. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that these recommendations be approved, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.

The Board considered Charter Resolution No. 84-5-1 which is a Charter Resolu-Ch. Ren. 84-5-1 tion exempting the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, from K.S.A. 19-262 and providing substitute provisions on the same subject. By this Charter Resolu-Levytax-amb tion the Board of County Commissioners is authorized by resolution to levy a tax for ambulance service purpose upon all taxable tangible property in the county not in excess of three mills on the dollar of assessed valuation of such property. This resolution shall be effective upon its publication in the official county newspaper. After complete review it was moved by Mr. Neis that this Charter Resolution be adopted, seconded by Mrs. Hiebert, and carried unanimously.
