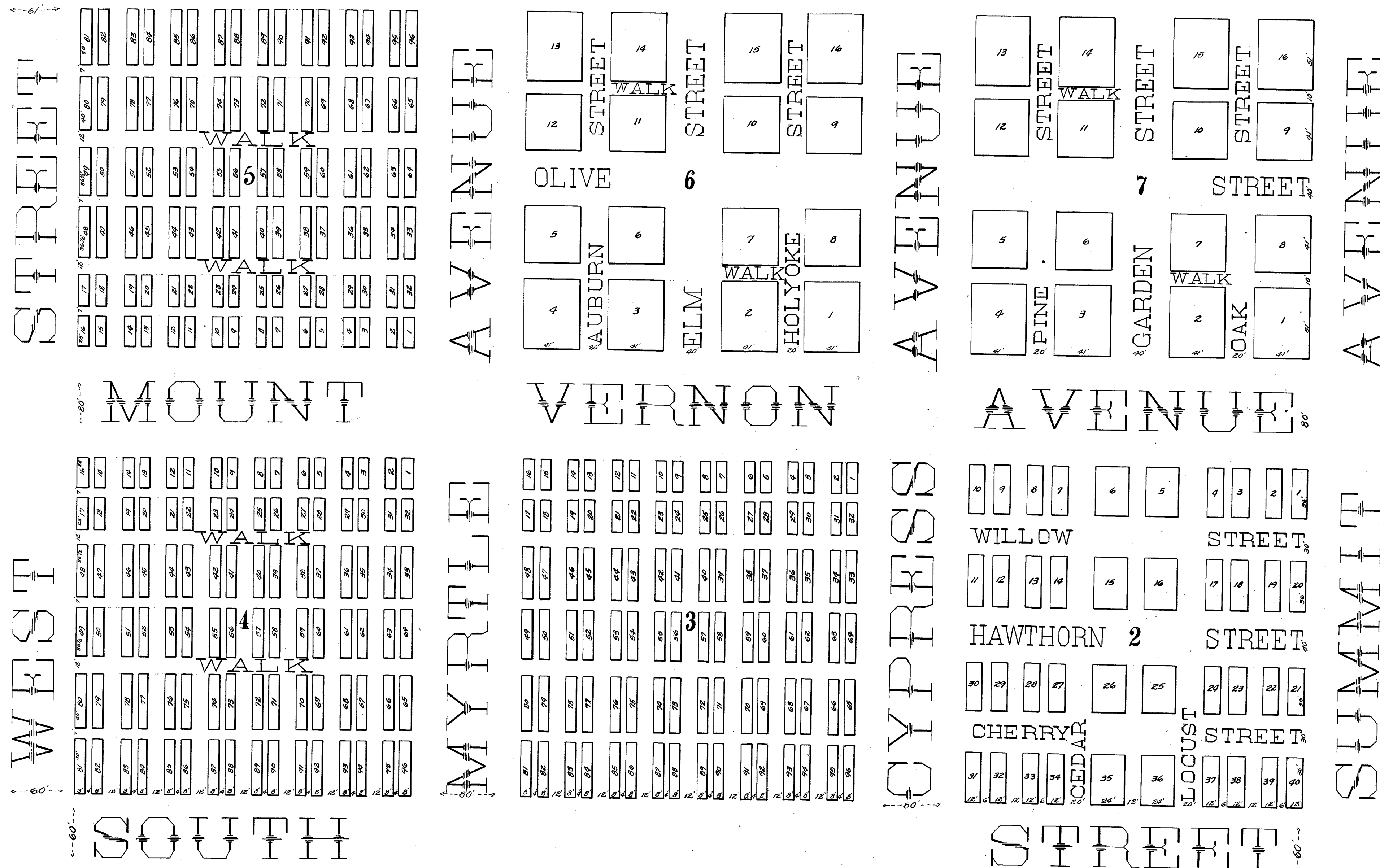

We, Geo. W. Paddock President, Henry Barricklow Vice President, H.D. Fisher Secretary, Nathan Taylor Treasurer and W.H. Schofield Agent, of the Kansas Educational Association of the Methodist Episcopal Church, do hereby set forth and Certify, that the Annexed Plat of a part of the Baldwin City Cemetery grounds (the title to which is vested in Association) is true and correct, and that the following is a correct description of the location of said Cemetery and the demensions of the Blocks, Lots, Avenues Streets, Walks and Alleys therein.

First, The Surveyed portion of the Cemetery as per this plat is located on the South half of the Southwest quarter of the North West quarter of Section No. ten (10) Township No. fifteen (15) Range No. twenty (20) in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, and Commencing at the Quarter Section Corner between Sections 9 & 10, Township 15 S. R. 20 E. and running thence North and East as indicated by the lines and figures on the plat.

South Street and West Street are each Sixty (60) feet wide. Mount Vernon Avenue, Myrtle Avenue, Cypress Avenue and Summit Avenue are each Eighty (80) feet in width. Olive Street, Elm Street, Garden Street and Hawthorn Street are each Forty (40) feet wide. Willow Street and Cherry Street are each Thirty (30) feet wide. Auburn Street, Holyoke Street, Pine Street, Oak Street, Willow Street and Cherry Street are each Twenty (20) feet wide.

The walks and Alleys are severally, Twelve (12) Ten (10) Seven (7) and Six (6) feet wide as marked on the plat.

All the Lots in Block Two (2) are Thirty-six (36) feet by Twelve (12) feet, excepting Lots No. Five (5), Six (6), Fifteen (15) Sixteen (16), Twenty-five (25), Twenty-six (26), Thirty-five (35) and Thirty-six (36) which last named lots are Thirty-six (36) feet by Twenty-four (24) feet.

The Lots in Block Three (3), Four (4) and Five (5) are numbered from One (1) to Thirty-two (32) inclusive are Twenty-three (23) feet by Eight (8) feet. Lots in the aforesaid Three Blocks, and numbered from Thirty-three (33) to Sixty-four (64) inclusive are Thirty-six and One half (36 1/2) feet by Eight (8) feet. Lots in the said Three Blocks and numbered from Sixty-five (65) to (96) Ninety-six inclusive are Forty (40) feet by Eighty (80) feet.

The Lots in Blocks Six (6) and Seven (7) and numbered One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), Fifteen (15) and Sixteen (16) are each Fifty-one (51) feet by Forty-one (41) feet, and Lots in said Blocks 6 & 7 and numbered Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) are each Forty-one (41) feet by Forty-one (41) feet. All as per plat hereunto Annexed and to which reference is made.

The Streets, Blocks, Lots, Avenues and Alleys are Set apart and conveyed for Cemetery and Sepulcher purpose only and subject and according to the Organization of the Baldwin City Cemetery Company established by Authority of an Act of the Legislature of the State of Kansas, and entered for record and Incorporation with the Register of Deeds in and for Douglas County Kansas.

In Witness whereof we the Officers of the Kansas Educational Association of the M.E. Church and also members of the Baldwin City Cemetery Company have hereunto set our hands and caused the seal of the Association to be attached this 3rd day of October 1864
