

HIGHLAND CEMETERY

I Marshall Dodder sole owner of the land herein described do hereby dedicate and set apart for the purposes of a Burial Ground to be known as Highland Cemetery that tract of land in Douglas County, State of Kansas described as follows: Commencing at the South West corner of the South West Quarter of Section No. Thirty-Two (32) Township No. Fourteen (14) of Range No. Eighteen, (18) Thence running East Two hundred and sixty-five (265) feet, thence North on a line parallel with the West line of the quarter Section Two hundred and eighty-nine (289) feet Thence West on a line parallel with the south line of said quarter Section Two hundred and sixty-five (265) feet. Thence South to place of beginning. (Excepting from said tract the portions on the South and West heretofore taken for County Road.) Said tract being subdivided into lots numbered from One to one hundred and ten inclusive. The dimensions of said lots are as marked on the plat, and the width of Alleys and driveways are also designated.

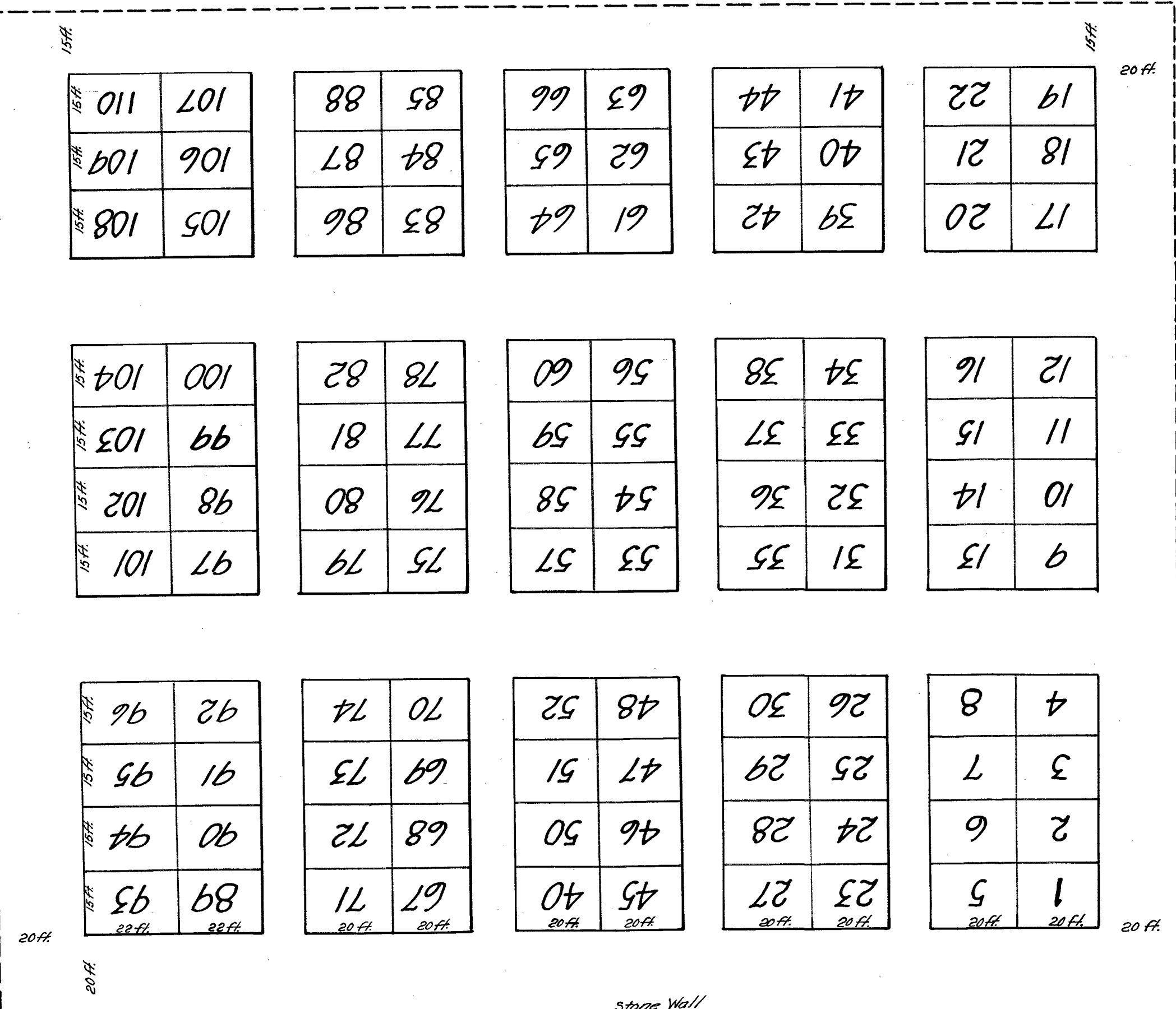
