

Kauwaka May 29th 1877.

The fence viewers of Kauwaka Township having met this day according to notice to divide a partition fence between the north west quarter of Sec thirty one (31) Township Twp 12 Range nineteen (19) said Land belonging to B. L. W. Manning, Mannings fence is situated six feet north of the line except twelve and one half rods on the east which is eight feet south of the line, and the south west quarter of Sec thirty one (31) Township Twp 12 Range nineteen (19) said fence being situated on the Land of E. A. Coleman eight feet south of the line.

It was then decided that said Coleman build and maintain a good and lawful fence on the east eighty one and a half rods.

And B. L. W. Manning build and maintain a good and lawful fence on the west eighty one and a half rods.

It was also decided that said Coleman has builded twelve and a half rods more than his just share of said fence, and that we the fence viewers of Kauwaka Township award to E. A. Coleman the sum of One Dollar and seventy five cents \$1.75 per rod for said twelve and a half rods, said award to be payed to E. A. Coleman by B. L. W. Manning.
