Agreement in regard to  
Division Line of Hedge Fence  
between Mary A. Dinsmoor and  
James Deay.

It appears that James Deay  
planted and cultivated a hedge on or near the  
line separating the N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 4 Town 14 and Range  
21 (owned by Mary A. Dinsmoor) from the N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of  
same Section owned by James Deay.

Witnesseth: That in consideration of Fifteen  
Dollars (\$15.00) in cash to him paid by the said  
Mary A. Dinsmoor the receipt of which is hereby  
acknowledged said James Deay transfers and assigns  
to the said Mary A. Dinsmoor the south one half of  
said line of hedge fence to be owned and kept  
in repair by her. It is further agreed that neither  
of the above named parties are to cut or to  
make openings or roadways or allow them to be  
made through said line of hedge without the  
written consent of the other party.

And it is further agreed that in consideration  
of the payment above mentioned James Deay is  
to "lay-down" said line of Hedge or cause it to be  
done before the first day of April 1880 and at  
that time to turn the south half of said line of  
hedge over to the said Mary A. Dinsmoor in  
good order. After which each of the above  
named parties is to maintain and keep in  
repair his respective one half of said line of
