The the fence viewers of Kanawaka Township have this day met to examine and divide the partition fence Land owned by John McIlwaine and J K Dunn the said line running between St. E 1/4 and S E 1/4 of Sec. 29 T. 12 R. 19 and have allotted to said J McIlwaine the East 80 R, being one half of said fence and J K Dunn the West half to build and maintain we further agree that the said parties must build a good lawful fence by the first day April 1880
