Now comes on this case for further deliberation,

Seventh Whereupon it is considered, agreed ^{and} adjudged by us that the value of said entire hedge partition fence (\$104⁰⁰) One hundred ^{and} four Dollars ^{and} the owner of said adjoining land, Mrs. S.R. Bell pay the said L. N. Snider the one half To wit, the sum of Fifty two Dollars (\$52⁰⁰).

Eighth We further find on actual view of said fence ^{and} on said application for assignment ^{and} severance that said fence along the entire line thereof shall be kept in repair by said parties in equal shares ^{and} assign ^{and} set apart the North half thereof to said L. N. Snider being eighty rods more or less commencing at the North end thereof ^{and} running to the center ^{and} set apart the South half thereof to said Mrs. S.R. Bell being eighty rods more or less commencing at the South end thereof ^{and} to the center each to be by them kept up ^{and} maintained at their several proper ^{and} personal expense ^{and} that the cost of this proceeding taxed at \$9 ²⁵/₁₀₀ be adjudged to be paid by Mrs. S.R. Bell.
