

This Instrument made this 6th day of October 1881
between Solomon Therto of Douglas County and State
of Kansas of the first part and Thomas H. Warren
of Douglas County and State of Kansas of the
second part:

Witnesseth; That the party of the first part in
consideration of the sum of Thirty Three Dollars
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby
grant and sell to the party of the second part the
following described land to-wit: Commencing at a
rock East from South west Corner of the North west
Quarter of section Eight (8) in town fourteen (14)
of range twenty One (21) in Douglas County in
the State of Kansas, thence East Eighty (80)
rods, the same being one half more or less, the
division fence between the South west and the
North west Quarters of said section. The said party
of the first part agrees to maintain and keep
in repair the said division fence.
