

To the Register of Deeds of Douglas Co. January 30, 1912.

We the undersigned fence veiwers of Lecompton Township, Douglas County, Kansas, met on the above date, and veiwed the partition fence, (same being a hedge fence) between the S.E. $\frac{3}{4}$ of the E. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 17, Twp 12, R. 19, said land being owned by Mrs. Sarah E. Jones and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of ~~XX~~ the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, Twp. 12, R. 19, and owned by Antonie Teson. We as fence veiwers for said township, measured said hedge fence, and find it to be eighty rods in length, and devided same giving the east fourty to said Sarah E. Jones, and the west fourty rods to said Antonie Teson. We also viewed partition fence (same being a hedge fence) between the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, Twp. 12, R. 19 (said land owned by Sarah E. Jones) and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 17, Twp. 12, R. 19, and owned by Antonie Tesot. We have measured said fence and find same to be about six hundred and fifty feet in length, and have devided same, giving the north one half of fence to said Antonie Teson and south one half to said Sarah E. Jones. Markers were placed in the ground at devision point in each fence.
