

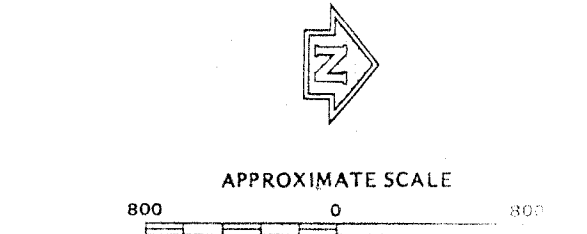

EXPLANATION OF ZONE DESIGNATION	
ZONE	EXPLANATION
A	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevation and flood hazard factors not determined.
A0	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding which are between one (1) and three (3) feet above the base flood elevation; base flood elevation and flood hazard factors are determined.
AH	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding which are between one (1) and three (3) feet above the base flood elevation; base flood elevation and flood hazard factors are determined.
A1-A30	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevation and flood hazard factors determined.
A99	Areas of 100-year flood to be protected by a protection system under construction; elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
B	Areas between limits of the 100-year flood; year flood; or certain areas subject to flooding with average depths less than one (1) foot from the contributing drainage area is less than one (1) mile; or areas protected by levees from the 100-year flood (Medium shading).
C	Areas of minimal flooding. (No shading).
D	Areas of undetermined, but possible, flood.
V	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity action; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors are determined.
V1-V30	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity action; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors are determined.

REFERENCE MARKS	ELEVATION FEET (NGVD)	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION
RM 1	875.99	A railroad spike in utility pole located at the southeast corner of intersection of Clinton Parkway and Kasold Drive.
RM 2	850.03	Top of fire plug at corner of Atchison Avenue and 26th Street.
RM 3	844.93	Corner of east left upstream headwall of culvert for Quail Creek under 24th Street.
RM 4	882.99	A chiseled square on top of south curb of 19th Street located about 170 feet west of center of intersection of 19th Street and Melholland Road.
RM 5	846.11	A chiseled square on top of concrete curbing located about 3 feet southeast of north median at intersection of U.S. Highway 59 and County Road, at corporate limits.
RM 6	852.84	A chiseled square on top of southwest corner of concrete headwall of culvert for Naasmith Creek under 23rd Street.
