Know ye that I Thomas Caney, Governor of the State of Kansas, reposing
special trust and confidence in the integrity patriotism & abilities
of Agquilla J. Reid on behalf and in the name of the State do
hereby appoint & commission him Notary Public in & for the
County of Douglas & do authorize & empower him to discharge
the duties of said office according to law. In testimony whereof
I have hereunto subscribed my hand & caused to be affixed
the great seal of the State. Done at Topeka this eighteenth
day of May A.D. 1864.

Public of Douglas County, State of Kansas by the Governor. Now if the said
Agquilla J. Reid shall faithfully & impartially perform all the duties of
his office as such Notary Public according to law then this obli-
gation to be void otherwise to be & remain in full force & virtue in law.
