Know ye that I Thomas Carney, Governor of the State of Kansas, re-
posing special trust and confidence in the integrity, patriotism and
capabilities of John Hutchings on behalf and in the name of the
State do hereby appoint and commission him Notary Public in & for the
County of Douglas & do authorize and empower him to discharge the duties
of said office according to law.

Topeka this Tenth day of December AD 1864
