Crawford Governor of the State of Kansas upon special trust & confidence in the integrity, patriotism & abilities of D. S. McKittrick on behalf & in the name of the State do hereby McKittrick appoint & commission him Notary Public in & for County of Douglas State of Kansas & do authorize & empower him to discharge the duties of said office according to law. In testimony whereof I have hereunto subscribed my hand & caused to be affixed the great seal of the State. Done at Topeka July 13 1865 This 13th day of July 1865.

Know all men by these presents that we D. S. McKittrick and Charles Chadwick of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas do hereby and jointly bind unto the State of Kansas aforesaid in the sum of five hundred dollars to be paid to the said State to which payment will truly to be made on bond or bonds on their execution & administration jointly & severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals, dated the 29th day of July in the year 1865.

The condition of this obligation is such that if the said D. S. McKittrick who has lately been appointed by the Governor of the State of Kansas to the office of Notary Public in & for the County of Douglas said State shall faithfully perform the duties of his said office according to law then this obligation shall be void otherwise to remain in full force & virtue.
