In testimony whereof I have hereunto subscribed my hand & caused to be affixed the great seal of the State. Done at Topeka this 9th day of November AD 1865.

Montgomery of the same place as sureties are held and firmly bound unto the State of Kansas in the penal sum of five hundred Dollars for the payment of which well and truly to be made we hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors & administrators by these presents. Sealed with our seals & dated this 11th day of November AD 1865. The condition of this obligation is such that whereas the above bounden John W. Horner was on the 9th day of November AD 1865 appointed & commissioned under the Seal of the State by S. J. Crawford Governor of the State of Kansas a Notary Public in and for the County of Douglas and State of Kansas. Now therefore if the said above bounden John W. Horner shall not faithfully perform the duties of his said office of Notary Public then this obligation shall be null and void.
