Crawford Governor of the State of Kansas, reposing special trust & confidence in the integrity patriotism and abilities of S. N. Walker on behalf and in the name of the State do hereby appoint & commission him Notary Public in & for County of Douglas, Kansas & do authorize & empower him to discharge the duties of said office according to law. In testimony whereof I have hereunto subscribed my hand & caused to be affixed the Great Seal of the State.
