Crawford, Governor of the State of Kansas, reposing especial trust & confidence in the integrity, patriotism & abilities of S. A. Stonebraker on behalf & in the name of the State do hereby appoint & commission him Notary Public in & for County of Douglas, State of Kansas & do authorize & empower him to discharge the duties of said officer according to law.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto subscribed my hand & caused the official Seal of the State to be hereunto affixed. Done at Topeka this 7th day of March A.D. 1866.

Stonebraker shall well & faithfully to the best of his skill & ability perform & execute the duties of his said office as Notary Public of Douglas County, Kansas during his continuance in office then the above obligation shall be void, otherwise the same shall remain in full force & effect in law.
