Crawford Governor of the State of Kansas reposing special trust & confidence in the integrity, patriotism & abilities of George A. Banks on behalf and in the name of the State do hereby appoint & commission him Notary Public in & for Douglas County and do authorize and empower him to discharge the duties of said Office according to law.

Done at Topeka this 4th day of May A.D. 1868.
