

Ch. 1905. The State of Kansas, to all who shall see these presents greeting. Know ye that I, Samuel J. Crawford Governor of the State of Kansas, reposing special trust & confidence in the integrity, patriotism & abilities of Aquila J. Reid, on behalf & in the name of the State, do hereby appoint & commission him to be a Justice of the Peace for Douglas County & do authorize & empower him to discharge the duties of said office according to law. In testimony whereof I have hereunto subscribed my hand & caused to be affixed the Great Seal of the State. Done at Topeka this 8th day of June A.D. 1868.

Sealed with our seals & dated this 11th day of September A.D. 1868. Now the condition of this obligation is such that whereas the above bounden Aquila J. Reid was on the 8th day of June A.D. 1868 duly appointed & commissioned by the Governor of the State of Kansas to the Office of Justice of the Peace in & for Douglas County in said State now the condition of this obligation is such that if the said Aquila J. Reid shall well & faithfully perform & execute the duties of the Office of Justice of the Peace of Douglas County according to law and to the best of his skill & ability during his continuance
