

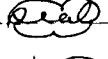
Know all men by these Presents

elected to the Office of Clerk of the District Court in & for
Douglas County in said State, that if said B. D. Palmer
shall truly and faithfully pay over to the proper person
or persons all moneys that may be by him received in
his official capacity and faithfully discharge the duties
of his said Office then this obligation shall be null and
void otherwise of full force & virtue in law.
