Garrett as jointors of the County of Douglas & State of Kansas are held and firmly bound unto the State of Kansas for said in the sum of Sixteen Thousand Dollars lawful money of the United States to be paid unto the said State of Kansas; to which payment well & truly to be made we jointly & severally bind ourselves, our heirs, executors & administrators firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this 10th day of January A.D. 1870. Whereas the above bounden James Walker was elected to the Office of Sheriff of the County of Douglas in the State of Kansas on the 2nd day of November A.D. 1869; Now the condition of this obligation is such that if the said James Walker shall well & faithfully perform & execute the duties of the Office of Sheriff of the said County of Douglas during his continuance in Office by virtue of said Election without fraud deceit or oppression and shall pay over all moneys that may come into his hands as such Sheriff and shall deliver to his successor all mite papers and other things pertaining to his Office which may be so required by Law, then the above obligation shall be void; otherwise to be & remain in full force & effect.
