That we Melancthon S. Beach of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas as principal & Robert Morron, O.E. Seamard & James Blood W.H. Duncan, John H. Wilder, Samuel Poole, Witter S. McCurdy R. W. Sudington & C. W. Babcock of the same place as sureties are held & firmly bound unto the Board of County Commissioners of the said County of Douglas in the penal sum of one Thousand Dollars to the payments whereof we jointly & severally bind ourselves each of us & our heirs, executors & administrators and each of them firmly by these presents. Stated with our seals and dated this 20th day of June 1870.

Whereas the above bounden Melancthon S. Beach was elected to the office of County Treasurer of Douglas County of said on the first day of November A.D. 1869; Now therefore the condition of this obligation is such that if the said Melancthon S. Beach and his Deputy and all persons employed in his office shall faithfully and promptly perform the duties of said office and if the said Melancthon S. Beach and his Deputy shall pay according to law all money which shall come into his hands as Treasurer and will render a just and true account thereof whenever required by said Board of Commissioners or by any provision of law & shall deliver on his successor in office or to any other person authorized by law to receive the same all money, books, papers & other things appertaining or belonging thereto then the above obligation shall void otherwise the same is in full force & effect.
