The conditions of this obligation are such that whereas the above bounden Paul R. Brooks was elected to the office of County Clerk of the County of Douglas on the Seventh day of November A.D. 1871 Now therefore if the said Paul R. Brooks shall faithfully perform all the duties of his office, and shall pay over all moneys that may come into his hands as such clerk as required by law and shall deliver to his successor in office all the books records papers and other things belonging to said office then the above obligation to be null and void; otherwise to remain in full force
