 persons employed in his office shall faithfully and
 promptly perform the duties of said office and if the said
 Theodore Poshler and his deputies shall pay according to law
 all moneys which shall come to his hands as treasurer and
 will render a true & just account thereof whenever required by
 said board of commissioners or by any provisions of law and
 shall deliver over to his successors in office or to any other
 persons authorized by law to receive the same all moneys books
 papers & other things appertaining thereto or belonging to his
 said office then these above obligations to be void otherwise to be
 in full force & effect
