Good as sureties of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas are hereby held and firmly bound unto the State of Kansas aforesaid in the sum of Two thousand Dollars lawful money of the United States to be paid unto the said State of Kansas, to which payment well and truly to be made we jointly and severally bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this first day of August A.D. 1874. Whereas the above bounden Henry B. Asher was appointed to the Office of Coroner of the County of Douglas in the State of Kansas on the 30th day of July A.D. 1874 now the condition of this obligation is such that if the said Henry B. Asher shall well and faithfully perform and execute the duties of the Office of Coroner of the said County of Douglas during his continuance in office by virtue of said appointment without fraud, deceit or oppression and shall pay over all moneys that may come into his hands as such Coroner and shall deliver to his successor all writs papers and other things pertaining to his Office which may be so required by Law then the above obligation shall be void otherwise to be and remain in full force and effect.
