Now the Conditions of this obligation is such that whereas the above bounden B.F. Diggs was on the 6th day of November A.D. 1877 duly elected to the office of County Clerk of Douglas County Kansas for the term of Two years

Now therefore if the said Benjamin F. Diggs shall faithfully and impartially discharge all the lawful duties of said office for the term for which he was elected and turn over to his successor in office the books papers money or other property in his hands belonging to said County then this obligation shall be void otherwise remain in full force and effect
