

Know all men by these presents, that I, Robt Morrow of Lawrence, County of Douglas and State of Kansas as principal and Martha Morrow, C. H. Babcock, Oliver Barber, C. Robinson, J. S. Emery, S. H. Carman & Alexander Lewis of County and State aforesaid as joint and several bondsmen unto the Board of County Commissioners of said County of Douglas in the principal sum of One hundred and Fifty Thousand \$100,000 & dollars whereof we jointly and severally hold our selves and each of us and our heirs executors and administrators and each of us by these presents sealed with our seal and dated this Lawrence Kansas June 3^d A.D. 1878.

The consideration of the foregoing obligation is such that whereas Robt Morrow was on the Tenth day of May A.D. 1878 by the Board of County Commissioners of the County aforesaid appointed to the Office of County Treasurer of the Douglas County State of Kansas to fill the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of James E. Watson

Now if the said Robt Morrow and his deputy and all persons employed by him in his office shall faithfully and promptly perform the duties of said office and of the said Robt Morrow and his deputies shall pay according to law all moneys which shall come to his hands as Treasurer and shall render a true and just account thereof whenever required by said Board of County Commissioners, and shall allow over to his successors in office or to any ^{person} authorized by law to receive the same all moneys books papers and all other things or property appurtenant thereto or belonging to his said office then the foregoing obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and effect
