One Thousand eight hundred and Seventy eight

Whereas the above bounden Oliver Barbé was on the 22^d day of November AD 1878 appointed to the office of County Treasurer of said County to fill the vacancy occasioned by the failure of James E. Watson Treasurer elect to give his bond

It is therefore the condition of this obligation is such that if the said Oliver Barbé and his deputy and all persons employed by in his office shall faithfully and promptly perform the duties of said office and if the said Barbé and his deputies shall pay, according to law all moneys which shall come into his hands as Treasurer, and will render a just and true account thereof whenever required by the board of Commissioners of said County or by any provision of law and shall deliver over to his successor in office or to any other person authorized by law to receive the same, all moneys, books and papers and other things appertaining thereto or belonging to his said office then the above obligation to be and otherwise to be in full force and effect
