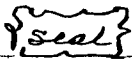


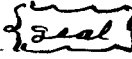

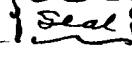

Dated Lawrence Kansas this 10th day of January, A.D. 1885.

The conditions of this obligation are, That whereas the above bounden R.A. French, was, on the fourth day of November A.D. 1884, elected to the office of County Attorney of the County of Douglas State of Kansas, Now if the said R.A. French shall safely keep all moneys which may be collected or received by him or which may otherwise come into his hands by virtue of this office, and pay the same over to the proper person or authority, and shall honestly and faithfully discharge and perform all and singular his duties as County Attorney, according to law, during his continuance in office, then this obligation shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
