Brooks, Jacob House, Geo Mmes and W Bromelsick as sureties are held and firmly bound unto the state of Kansas in the penal sum of one hundred thousand dollars to the true and lawful payment of which we bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators dated August twenty fifth A.D. 1884.

The condition of this obligation is such that- whereas the above bounden Horace L. Mome was elected to the office of County Treasurer of the County of Douglas on the third day of November one thousand eight hundred and eighty four. Now therefore if the said Horace L. Mome and his deputy and all persons employed in his office shall faithfully and promptly perform the duties of said office and if the said Horace L. Mome and his deputies shall pay according to law all moneys which shall come to his hands as Treasurer and will render a just and true account thereof whenever required by the Board of Commissioners of said County or by any provision of law and shall deliver over to his successor in office or to any person authorized by law to receive the same all moneys books papers and other things appertaining thereto or belonging to his said office, then the above obligation to be void otherwise to be in full force and effect.
