D. 1890, duly elected County Commissioner of the First District of Douglas County, State of Kansas for the term commencing on the second Monday in January A. D. 1891. Now if the said Oliver Butler shall well and faithfully perform the duties of County Commissioner for said District until his successor is elected and qualified then this obligation shall be void otherwise to be and remain in full force and effect
