

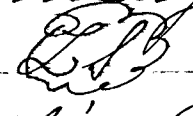

D. 1889 Now if the said John Walton shall well and faithfully perform the duties of County Commissioner for said district until his successor is elected and qualified then this obligation shall be void otherwise to be and remain in full force and effect.

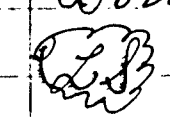

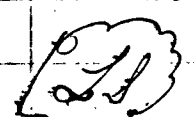
