Soxman shall safely keep all the moneys which may be collected or received by him or which may otherwise come into his hands by virtue of this office, and pay the same over to the proper person, or authority and that he will faithfully, correctly, and impartially perform all the duties of his said office and shall deliver to his successor in office all books, records, maps, deeds, mortgages, papers and things belonging to his office then this obligation shall be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
