NOW, THEREFORE, if the Principal shall, during the term of two (2) years beginning on the 13th day of October 1953, well and faithfully perform all and singular the duties incumbent upon him by reason of his election or appointment as aforesaid and honestly account for all moneys coming into his hands according to law, then this obligation shall be null and void; otherwise of full force and virtue.

This bond is executed by the Surety upon the following express condition, which shall be a condition precedent to the right of recovery hereunder:

That regardless of the number of years this Bond shall continue or be continued in force, or be renewed, and of the number of annual premiums that shall be payable or paid, the Surety shall not be liable hereunder for more in the aggregate than the above named penalty.
