WHEREAS, the said Principal has been duly elected or appointed County Engineer of Douglas County for the term beginning January 12, 1953 and ending January 10, 1955.

NOW THEREFORE, the condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above Principal shall well and faithfully perform all the duties of his said office as required by law, then this obligation to be null and void; otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.

This bond is given and received under the following express conditions:

The term of this bond shall be from the 12th day of January, 1953, to the 10th day of January, 1955.

That if the Surety shall so elect, it may give notice in writing to obligee terminating its liability under this bond for any default of the Principal occurring after the expiration of thirty (30) days from the date of such notice, and this bond shall be deemed cancelled at the expiration of thirty (30) days after such notice has been given.

That the Surety hereunder shall not be liable for any loss which may be sustained through the failure of any bank or banks or other depository to pay or deliver over any moneys and securities deposited with it by the said Principal which may come into his hands by virtue of his said office.
