KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That ROY FLORY, Lawrence, Kansas as Principal, (hereinafter called Principal) and AMERICAN BONDING COMPANY OF BALTIMORE, a corporation of the State of Maryland, having its principal office in the City of Baltimore, Maryland, as Surety (hereinafter called Surety), are held and firmly bound unto the STATE OF KANSAS in the penalty of FIFTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 (50,000.00) Dollars, to the payment whereof, well and truly to be made and done, the Principal binds himself, his heirs, executors, and administrators, and the Surety binds itself, its successors and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the said Treasurer and his deputy, and all persons employed in his office, shall faithfully and promptly perform the duties of said office, and if the said Treasurer and his deputies shall pay, according to law, all moneys which shall come to his hands as Treasurer, and will render a just and true account thereof whenever required by the Board of Commissioners or by any provision of law, and shall deliver over to his successors in office or to any other person authorized by law to receive the same, all moneys, books, papers and other things appertaining thereto or belonging to his said office, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
