Schaaque shall honestly and faithfully perform and execute the duties of said office required of him by law, during his continuance therein, by virtue of said election, and pay over to the proper person or authority all moneys that may come into his hands by virtue of said office, and deliver to his successor all books, records, papers, and other things belonging to his said office, which may be so required by law, then the above obligation shall be void; otherwise to be and remain in full force and effect.
