NOW THEREFORE, the condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden C. E. REDMOND shall well and faithfully perform all the duties of his said office of Acting County Engineer as required by law, then this obligation to be null and void; otherwise to be and remain in full force and viture.

This bond is given and received under the following express conditions:

The term of this bond shall be from the 1st day of March 1943 to the 1st day of March 1944.

That if the Surety shall so elect, it may give notice in writing to Board of County Commissioners, Douglas County, Kansas terminating its liability under this bond for any default of the Principal occurring after the expiration of thirty (30) days from the date of such notice, and this bond shall be deemed cancelled at the expiration of thirty (30) days after such notice has been given.

That the Surety hereunder shall not be liable for any loss which may be sustained through the failure of any bank or banks or other depository to pay or deliver over any moneys and securities deposited with it by the said C. E. REDMOND which may come into his hands by virtue of his said office.
