KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we Harold A. Beck of Lawrence, Kansas, as principal, and THE TRAVELERS INDEMNITY COMPANY, a corporation of Hartford, Connecticut, as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto State of Kansas in the penal sum of Two thousand and 00/100 - - (\$2,000.00) Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, said principal binds himself, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, and said Surety binds itself, its successors and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

WHEREAS, the said principal has been elected to the office of Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas for a definite term beginning January 13, 1947 and ending January 10, 1949 and is required to furnish a bond for the faithful performance of the duties of the said office or positions.

NOW, THEREFORE THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION is such that if the above bounden principal shall (except as hereinafter provided) faithfully perform the duties of his said office or position during the said term, and shall pay over to the persons authorized by law to receive the same all moneys that may come into his hands during the said term without fraud or delay, and at the expiration of said term, or in case of his resignation or removal from office, shall turn over to his successor all records and property which have come into his hands, then this obligation to be null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that if the Surety shall so elect, this bond may be canceled by giving thirty (30) days notice in writing to the Oblige and this bond shall be deemed canceled at the expiration of thirty (30) days from the mailing of such notice. If this provision shall be held void, this entire bond shall be void.
