 State of Kansas of the first part and Charles B. Peck of Port-
 Huron Michigan of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part in con-
 sideration of the sum of Sixty Five Dollars to her duly
 paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged hath sold
 and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and mortgage to
 the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever
 all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas
 and State of Kansas described as follows to wit, Lot No. Fortyone
 (41) on Pennsylvania Street in the City of Lawrence according to
 the plat of said City on file and Recorded in the office of the Register
 of Deeds in and for said County, with the appurtenances and
 all the estate title and interest of the said party of the first
 part therein And the said Sarah Hayes doth hereby cov-
 enant and agree that at the delivery hereof she is the lawful
 owner of the premises above granted and seized of a good
 and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear
 of all incumbrances.

This Debt is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment
 of the sum of Sixty Five Dollars according to the terms of the
 certain promissory note this day executed by the said Sarah
 Hayes to the said party of the second part due in 6 months
 from the date thereof with interest from date until paid at
