

This Indenture this Twenty ninth day of January
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and eighty one between George Morton and Agnes Morton
 his wife of "Palmer" in the County of Douglas and State
 of Kansas of the first part and Ann Reed of Wakarusa
 in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the second part.
 Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part for and
 in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars
 to her duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
 have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell ^{and}
 mortgage to the said party of the second part their heirs
 and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situate
 in the County of _____ and State of Kansas described as
 follows to wit Being thirty acres off of the South part
 of the South West quarter of Section Eight Town Fourteen
 Range No. Twenty also Twenty acres off the North West
 corner of the South West Quarter of Section No. nine
 Town Fourteen of Range Twenty, with the appurtenances
 and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the
 first part thereon.

This Grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the
 payment of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars
 according to the terms of a certain note made this day by
 the said George Morton & Agnes Morton his wife to the
 said Ann Reed of Four Hundred Dollars payable in
 three years from this date with interest at eight per cent
 Interest paid annually till paid.

And this conveyance shall be void if such payment be
 made as is herein specified But if default be made in said
 payment or any part thereof as provided then this conveyance
 shall become absolute and it shall be lawful for said party
 of the second part their executors administrators and
 assigns at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby
 granted or any part thereof in the manner prescribed by
 law and out of all the moneys arising from such sale
 to retain the amount then due for principal and interest
 and also for statutory damages in case of protest
 together with the costs and charges of making such
 sale and five per cent on the amount secured by
 this mortgage as a reasonable attorneys fee for foreclosure
 hereof and the surplus if any there be shall be paid by
 the parties making such sale to the said parties of the
 first part their heirs or assigns and for the
