This Indenture made this ninth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one between William Crum and Mary McCrum his wife of the city of Lawrence in the county of Douglas and state of Kansas of the first part and John Hutchinson of same place of the second part:

Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and state of Kansas described as follows to wit: Lots numbered thirteen (13) and fourteen (14) in Block number five of Kansas first addition to the said City of Lawrence Douglas County and State of Kansas with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said William Crum and Mary McCrum do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein and will warrant and defend the same and that the same is free and clear of all incumbrances. This grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars (\$150) in two years after date hereof with interest thereon at the rate of ten per cent per annum payable semi-annually according to the terms of one certain note this
