Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Fourteen Hundred Dollars, to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows to-wit: Lot, number Two (2), and the West half of the South half of the fractional South East quarter of Section number Thirty-Three (33) Township Twelve (12), Range Twenty (20) containing Sixty-Six (66) acres more or less
