200 Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which  
is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents  
do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party  
of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all  
that tract or parcel of land situate in the County of

The North half of the South East quarter of Section  
Eighteen (18) Township Fourteen (14) Range Eighteen (18)  
with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest  
of the said party of the first part therein.
