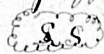

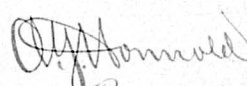

This Indenture made this tenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one between James Wilson Wm. P. Wilson and John S. Wilson all unmarried men of County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Martin Baltimore of Crenshaw Washington County New York of the second part:

Witnesseth that the parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Four thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract and parcel of land situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit:

The north east quarter of Section eleven (11) and North 18th 1/2 acres of South east quarter of Section eleven (11) all in Township North (12) of Range Nineteen (19) in Douglas County Kansas with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.

And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear from all incumbrances and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever.

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Four thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars according to the terms of four certain promissory notes executed by the said parties of the
