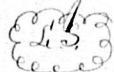

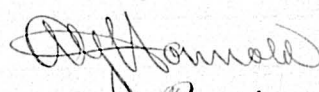

This Indenture made this 22^d day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one between James G. Goho and Mary Elizabeth Goho his wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Theodore Pochter of same place of the second part:

Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Six hundred Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit:

Lot No. 5 in W. on Massachusetts Street in the City of Lawrence according to the plat of said City on file and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances except a mortgage to C. A. Davis. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment
