and Emily Wright his wife of Palmyra in the County

Benjamin F. Sweet of Baldwin in the County of
Douglas and State of Kansas of the second part.
Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part for
in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars
to them duly paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledged have sold and by these presents do grant
conveyance sell and mortgage to the said party of the se-
cond part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract
or parcel of land situate in the County of Douglas and
State of Kansas described as follows to wit:
Lots one (1) two (2) three (3) four (4) nine (9) ten (10)
eleven (11) and twelve (12) in block sixty eight in
Palmyra Douglas County Kansas.
With the appurtenances and all the estate title and inter-
est of the said parties of the first part therein.
