Know all men by these presents

That I, John N. Corttall of Kingham in the County of Plymouth ^{and} Commonwealth of Massachusetts owner of a certain mortgage given by Edward Kavanagh of Peabody State of Maine to Herbert Miswall of Boston State aforesaid dated January 1st A.D. 1876 ^{and} Recorded with Douglas County State of Kansas Deeds, Libro, 16 folio 191 in consideration of Three Hundred dollars paid by Edward Kavanagh the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby assign, transfer and set over unto the said Kavanagh the said mortgage deed the real estate thereby conveyed and the note and claim thereby secured

To have and to hold the same to the said Edward Kavanagh and his heirs and assigns to their own use and behoof forever subject nevertheless to the conditions therein contained and to redemption according to law
