Witnesseth, That said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Sixteen Hundred Dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do by these presents Grant Bargain, Sell^{and} Convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns all the following described Real Estate situated in the County of Douglas^{and} State of Kansas, to wit; The South East quarter of Section twenty eight (28), in township fourteen (14) and range eighteen (18), being the same land this day conveyed to the said John Eno by said Albert Ottaway & wife To have^{and} to hold the same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments^{and} appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining forever; Provided Always, And these presents are upon this express condition that whereas said John Eno has this day executed and delivered his certain promissory note in writing to said party of the second part of which the following is a copy to wit,
