This Indenture Made this Thirtieth day of September
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
eighty and between Ralph L Williams and Mary
Williams his wife of Wakarusa, Douglas County Kansas
of the first part and Marshall W Weir, of Belleville Illinois
of the second part.

Witnessed, That the said parties of the first part for and
in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand Six Hun-
dred (4600) Dollars to them in hand paid by the said party
of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and
acknowledged have granted bargained sold and conveyed
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey
unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and
assigns forever all the following described pieces and
parcels of land lying and situate in the Township of
Wakarusa County of Douglas and State of Kansas to wit
(1) The West Half of the South West quarter of Section
Three (3) Township Thirteen (13), of Range Twenty (20),
(2) The Southeast quarter of Section Four (4), Township
Thirteen (13) of Range Twenty (20), less the Southeast quarter
of the Southwest quarter of said quarter Section and less
two (2) acres in the Southeast quarter of the Southeast
quarter of said quarter section used as a Cemetery
(3) The South West quarter of Section Fifteen (15), Township
Thirteen (13), of Range Twenty (20), less the West Twenty (20)
acres of the North half of said quarter Section.
(4) All the Northeast quarter of Section Twenty two (22)
Township Thirteen (13), of Range Twenty (20), north of
Wakarusa River
(5) All that part of the West half of the Northwest
quarter of Section Twenty two (22), Township Thirteen (13),
Range Twenty (20), lying North of the centre of Wakarusa River.
To have and to hold the same with all and singular the
hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging
unto the party of the second part and to his heirs and
assigns forever. And the said Ralph L Williams and
Mary Williams his wife do hereby covenant and agree
that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners
of the premises above granted and seized of a good and
indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear
of all incumbrances and that they will warrant and
defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession
of the said party of the second part his heirs and
assigns forever against all persons lawfully
claiming the same.
