This Indenture made this 22nd day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one between Anson Storm an unmarried man of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and The Baconia Savings Bank of Baconia New Hampshire of the second part:

Witnesseth that the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred Dollars to him duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has sold and by these presents does grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part and assigns forth all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit: The South half of Lot No. Seventy eight (78) on Massachusetts Street in the City of Lawrence in said County and State according to the plat said City with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said party of the first part therein.
